CSHP joins other state and national organizations seeking additional protections for residents and staff living and working in long-term care facilities. The letter to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services seeks the following:

The letter is seeking the following:

- Allow hospitals to provide the COVID-19 vaccine to any individual who is willing before transfer to a LTC community.
- Improve vaccination rates by allowing staff of LTC facilities to administer vaccinations
- Allow LTC pharmacists to vaccinate family members and caregivers visiting nursing home residents.
- Increase reimbursement strategies for COVID-19 vaccine delivery, administration, documentation, and storage and handling.

COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Errors and Deviations

CDC - A vaccine administration error is any preventable event that may cause or lead to inappropriate use of vaccine or patient harm. This table provides resources for preventing and reporting COVID-19 vaccine administration errors, as well as actions to take after an error has occurred. For completeness, it includes additional scenarios that deviate from CDC recommendations for vaccine intervals but are not considered administration errors.

SARS-CoV-2 Infection after Vaccination in Health Care Workers in California

NEJM- Data from phase 3 clinical trials of messenger RNA (mRNA) vaccines through November 2020 showed 94.1% efficacy for the prevention of symptomatic severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) infection at 14 days after the second dose of the mRNA-1273 vaccine (Moderna) and 95% efficacy at 7 days after the second dose of the BNT162b2 vaccine (Pfizer). Since the results of these trials were published, a nationwide surge in coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) has been noted, SARS-CoV-2 variants with increased infectivity have emerged, the Food and Drug Administration has granted emergency use authorization for these two mRNA vaccines, and vaccination has been initiated across the United States.
