I am a graduate of UCSF School of Pharmacy (1977) and completed a pediatric residency at USC School of Pharmacy (1978). After working briefly at UCLA Medical Center, I settled into a long career with Kaiser Permanente, retiring from Kaiser after 37 years of service in 2016. I worked as a pediatric pharmacist at the Kaiser Los Angeles Medical Center for nearly 25 years. I oversaw the implementation of various distributive services such as unit dose packaging on the pediatric units for tablets, oral syringes, IV syringes, and IV solutions. I also collaborated to establish a pediatric satellite and provided clinical tertiary pediatric pharmacy services. I implemented pharmacist participation in daily pediatric medical rounds and in pediatric code blues. I acted as a pharmacy preceptor for many years to pharmacy students from USC, UCSF, and Western schools of pharmacy and as a resident preceptor



in Kaiser's residency program. Later in my career I joined the Los Angeles Kaiser Pharmacy management team until my retirement.

For some, it is hard to imagine that many pharmacy services that are now considered routine were once leading- edge practices. Pharmacists attending medical rounds comes to mind. I remember the deep sense of pride I felt when the medical team waited for me to arrive for medical rounds because I was running a few minutes behind schedule. Their comment was that they needed "their pharmacist" on rounds! This gave me a great sense of job satisfaction that would had been impossible without the support of Kaiser Pharmacy management, great pharmacy technician support and nursing staff support.

As we all know, keeping up to date with new ideas, drug treatments, new theories and clinical studies is challenging for us all. 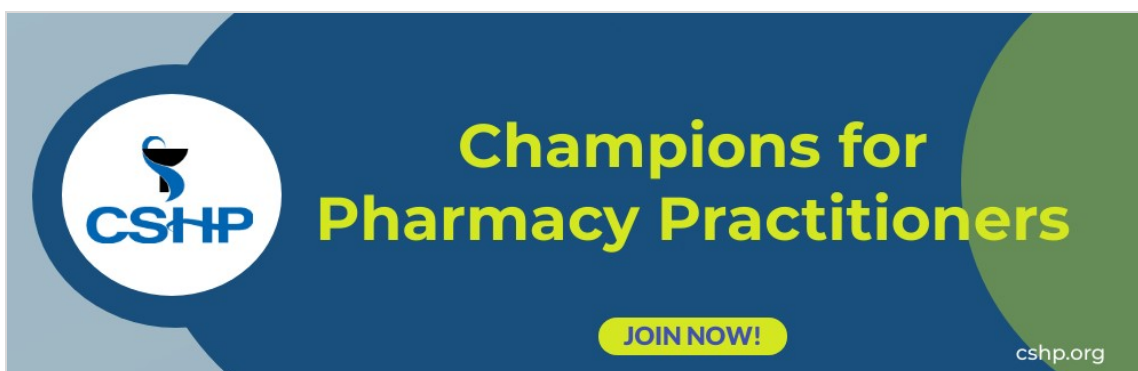

JAMA - In the first 10 months of their availability, covid-19 vaccines prevented an estimated 1.5 million coronavirus infections, nearly 73,000 hospitalizations, and almost 20,000 deaths in California, according to a study published Friday in the journal JAMA Network Open.

Health Disparities in Pharmacy Practice Within the Community: Let's Brainstorm for Solutions

PubMed - Health disparity is defined as a type of health difference that is closely linked with social, economic and/or environmental disadvantage. Over the past two decades, major efforts have been undertaken to mitigate health disparities and promote health equity in the United States. Within pharmacy practice, health disparities have also been identified to play a role in influencing pharmacists' practice across various clinical settings. However, well-characterized solutions to address such disparities, particularly within pharmacy practice, are lacking in the literature. Recognizing that a significant amount of work will be necessary to reduce or eliminate health disparities, the University of California, Irvine (UCI) School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences held a webinar in June 2021 to explore pertinent issues related to this topic.

Advocates Are Pushing For A Health Equity And Racial Justice Fund In California. Here's What It Would Do

CapRadio - Cultiva La Salud is part of a coalition of 25 legislators, 11 co-sponsors and almost 200 organizations asking Gov. Gavin Newsom set aside at least \$100 million in ongoing funding in his upcoming budget proposal for the Health Equity and Racial Justice Fund. The fund, which had gained some traction in 2021 but was ultimately not included in the state budget, would be used as a source for grants to tribes and community-based organizations addressing public health, from supporting transportation solutions to preventing gun violence — part of what advocates say are social determinants of health.
