AB 2571 — We Need Your Continued Support!

We are excited to share an important milestone for California pharmacy practice: [AB 2571: Reimbursement for Pharmacist Services](#) will advance on consent out of the Assembly Health Committee, signaling strong, unified support and continued momentum for this critical legislation.

AB 2571 is a key priority for CSHP, modernizing reimbursement policy to better reflect the care pharmacists already provide. The bill allows for pharmacists to bill

the Medi-Cal program and Health Plan in addition to the current billing by pharmacies — ultimately improving patient access to pharmacist-led care.

However, our work is far from over.

As many of you recall, this bill stalled in the Assembly Appropriations Committee in a prior cycle. That makes the next step especially critical—and why your voice matters now more than ever. Send in your letters of support to the Assembly Appropriations Committee through our e-system below!

Requirement for Provider Enrollment in Medi-Cal

Medi-Cal Rx - Pursuant to Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Title 42, Section 455.410(b), the "State Medicaid agency must require all ordering or referring physicians or other professionals providing services under the State Plan or waiver of the plan to be enrolled as participating providers." Additionally, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code (W&I Code), Section 14043.26(a), which was effective January 1, 2004, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is required to enroll Ordering, Referring and Prescribing (ORP) providers in Medi-Cal.
