December Spotlight

Budget Update – Since the budget was passed this fall, the Governor has unveiled a holdback plan that makes additional funding reductions. These include a "Delayed Start," which is essentially eliminating the first grant payment for grant funded programs, including CLC. This cut, combined with an overall 10% reduction, leaves CLC with approximately 33% less funding for the current year than was originally announced. While this is not good news for CLC, we have plans in place to manage the shortfall in the current year, and to expand program and revenue sources in the years to come.
