Research: Support research by CTTC members.

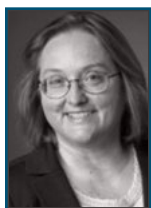
Patients, Families and Caregivers: Support patient led initiatives and activities

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ABOUT THE CTTC BMT REGISTRY

The CTTC Registry is a clinical database, containing detailed information on Canadians who have undergone autologous or allogeneic transplant in Canada. Data are available on over 16,000 patients from 15 Canadian transplant centres, going back to 1990, and several research projects are underway. Planning for this project started in 2012, and has progressed quickly from the idea stage to full operations in just over 3 years.

Through a partnership with the Centre for International Blood and Marrow Transplant Research, Canadian centres submit data on transplant recipients once, and have data included in both the international and Canadian transplant registries. Data are submitted at the time of transplant, and at regular intervals after transplant. This tool will be an invaluable resource for the Canadian stem cell transplant community. Potential users include clinical researchers, industry partners, and health system planners.

ASK THE REGISTRY!

The BMT registry is a very useful resource for collecting Canadian data related to blood and marrow transplant in Canada. Depending on your level of sponsorship, your company will have the opportunity to ask specific questions of the registry. Not sure what to ask? See a list of possible questions below. Please note that the purpose of this list is to provide you with examples of what can be asked of the registry, and that questions that may be asked are not limited to those outlined here.

1. How many allogeneic transplants done last year used busulfan as part of the conditioning regimen?
2. Have the number of transplants done for multiple myeloma increased over time?
3. How many transplant patients died last year from invasive fungal disease?
4. What are commonly used GVHD prophylaxis regimens in Canada? How has this changed over time?
