LAW SCHOOL GRAD <2YR \$0 | >2YRS \$140
 Any person who, although not admitted to practice before the Bar of Ohio or another state or territory of the US, holds a degree from an accredited law school. Law School Graduates less than two-years - no dues apply. Greater than two years the fee is \$140.

LAW STUDENT \$0
 Any person enrolled in an accredited law school and maintains the standards set forth.

PARALEGAL \$110
