TO THE OCVI-19 PUBLIC HEALTH :
EMERGENCY : **JOURNAL ENTRY**

On March 9, 2020, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued Executive Order 2020-01D, declaring a State of Emergency in response to the growing COVID-19 public health emergency.

In response the Oakwood Municipal Court makes the following Order:

1. All traffic and criminal arraignments, pre-trials, trials, civil and small claims hearings are hereby continued until after April 30, 2020 except:
 - a. Initial Hearings for detained Defendants;
 - b. Emergency hearings deemed appropriate by the Court;
 - c. Ex Parte hearings regarding protection orders;
 - d. Weddings currently scheduled will proceed, but will take place outside in the courtyard;

2. At this time the Clerk's office will remain open limited hours but encourages the following:
 - a. Payments be made via our court website at www.oakwood.oh.us or by mail;
 - b. Filings be made by fax at 937-297-2939 or by mail;

Additionally, for all Oakwood Municipal Court matters that are currently pending, counsel and any prose parties will be contacted by mail of their new court dates.
