

Classification at AHS Accredited Shows

Please make certain that EVERY scape is checked before it is placed on the show tables. Doing so saves disappointment and embarrassment. It is recommended that a computer (laptop or desktop) is used and that the AHS *Cultivar Online Database* (<http://www.daylilies.org>) or the AHS Electronic Registration Checklist CD is used for classification. This year, checking registered daylilies is easier than ever before.

Step 1

Once the small screen of the current registration database is open on your computer, look for the words, "Click here for Advanced Search" on the upper right side, and click on the words. See below.

- A new screen will open up (see below). Key/Type in the cultivar name.

- Scroll down to the bottom and click on the empty box beside the words "display flower show section." Then, click on the SEARCH button (see below)

Step 3

The pop-up “Search Results” screen (below) shows the horticulture show section **[large]** into which the cultivar is to be placed. Look on “Search Results” below for pinkish-lavender colored type in Italics.

Accordingly, ‘Gisela’s Sunshine’ is to be placed in Horticulture Div. I, On-Scape, Section 2: Large Flowers.

Example #2

- Key in ‘Heavenly Starfire’ in the “Advanced Search” option of the AHS registration database and click a checkmark in the box “display flower show sections.” Then, click on SEARCH button.

The “Search Result,” below, indicates that the cultivar is a multiform-registered daylily (Unusual Form, 10% poly) is to be entered in the Horticulture Division I On-Scape Section 7, **[unusual form+extra-large]**.

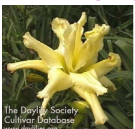
