Dues Waiver Policy and Application

The Dues Waiver Program is intended to help its members by providing assistance to attorneys whose financial circumstances are such that full payment of membership dues would pose a financial hardship. Participation in the program is limited to two consecutive membership years.

Eligibility:

- Only those applicants who have been DCBA members for one year or more are eligible to apply.
• Applicants must attest that payment of full dues constitutes a financial hardship.
• Applicants must complete this form and provide a letter explaining the circumstances surrounding the financial difficulty. Applicants are encouraged to provide documentation of the hardship.
• Applications remain confidential.

In the year following one's participation in the program, members will receive an invoice for the full dues amount. Dues Waiver Program participants are considered full active DCBA members as provided under the bylaws.
