MEETING MINUTES

November 15, 2016

Call to Order

Dr. Stephen Mandia, Chair, called a meeting of the DCMS Public Health Committee to order on April 19, 2016, at 6:04 pm, at the Duval County Medical Society, 1301 Riverplace Blvd, Suite #1638, Jacksonville, FL 32207.

Minutes April 19, 2016

Dr. Mandia presented the April 19, 2016, Public Health Committee Minutes to the Committee for approval.

Old Business

Dr. Mandia announced to the committee that Dr. Joseph Sabato had recently relocated. He thanked Dr. Sabato for his work on hands only CPR. Dr. Mandia acknowledged that the committee was not able to meet in August as planned due to the loss of DCMS Executive Assistant, Patti Ruscito.

Tammy Chaney, newly appointed Director of Operations, took a moment to introduce herself to the committee. She gave a brief update and directed attendees to the handout detailing updates on 904 Mission One Million, the Future of Healthcare Conference, and the newly finalized Physician Wellness Program. Ms. Chaney announced that the 904 Mission One Million website is functional.

New Business

Scott Tarzwell with the Department of Health in Duval County gave a presentation on the Medical Reserve Corps in the area. Mr. Tarzwell explained who the MRC consists of, the MRC mission, network, what the MRC does and provides, requirements of the MRC, (non) activation roles, previous activations, and prior year's volunteer hours.

Mr. Tarzwell then gave an update on the infection count of the Zika Virus in the state of Florida, as well as the cause of infection. He informed the committee that

the Miami/Miami Beach area currently has the highest Zika transition rates in Florida, and that influenza like symptoms are no greater than expected in the area.

Next Meeting

Dr. Mandia stated that the next Public Health meeting will be determined at a later time. The committee plans to meet 3 times in 2017.

Dr. Harmon then made a few suggestions of topics to add to the Foundation's next meeting agenda.
