At the Duval County Medical Society, the Clay County Medical Society, and the Nassau County Medical Society, we understand Seniors are often overwhelmed and uncertain about their options for **Traditional Medicare** and **Medicare Advantage**.

The decisions seniors make over their coverage can have a significant impact on their health in their golden years. We strongly believe seniors should have tools to determine if Medicare Advantage represents a better option than Traditional Medicare.

We also believe that seniors should be armed with actionable information on how each plan works with physicians to deliver timely and quality health care.

Duval County Medical Society, the Clay County Medical Society, and the Nassau County Medical Society have teamed up with physician organizations across the State to create the **Physician's Guide for Florida Seniors** and their caregivers, to evaluate plan performance and make the right decision for their families.

Considerations to Make When Choosing Medicare Advantage



According to information available from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, **“Medicare Advantage is a Medicare-approved plan from a private company that offers an alternative to Original Medicare.”**

The percentage of patients electing to forgo traditional Medicare for a private insurance company continues to grow, reaching 54% of seniors eligible for Medicare in 2024. While seniors are overwhelmed with marketing and promotional materials each October touting the benefits of giving up their traditional Medicare plan, there is seldom sufficient information to inform seniors on what Medicare protections they are giving up when choosing to participate in Medicare Advantage.

Those protections include:

- The ability to choose your physician. (Medicare Advantage Plans use closed networks)
- Protection from stringent treatment authorization guidelines from some plans. (Medicare Advantage Prior Authorization Denial rates ranges from 4.2% to 13%)
- Limited access to medications through Step Therapy protocols (Medicare Advantage plans are able to require enrollees to fail a less expensive or preferred medication before covering a medication requested by the treating physician)
- Restrictive access to medications. (Each plan has its own formulary, which determines which drugs are covered and at what cost-sharing level)
- The potential of being trapped in Medicare Advantage if pre-existing conditions jeopardize a Senior’s access to supplemental insurance when attempting to return to Traditional Medicare

Physicians Standing with Patients to Help You Make Informed Decisions

As of 2025, Florida has **613 licensed Medicare Advantage Plans**, offered by **30 different companies**, making it almost impossible for seniors to navigate this landscape effectively and select which plan will perform best for their individual needs.

The rankings contained in this guide were provided directly from **physicians across the state that work with Medicare Advantage companies** on a daily basis in an effort to provide quality and timely care for their patients.

The guide focuses on the most common barriers our patients face when utilizing a Medicare Advantage plan including: **Network Adequacy; Prior Authorization; Drug Formularies;** and **Step Therapy.**

Finally, it provides data on the stark reality for seniors considering leaving traditional Medicare and potentially **exposing themselves to underwriting requirements for Medicare Supplemental Insurance** if they decide to return at a later date.

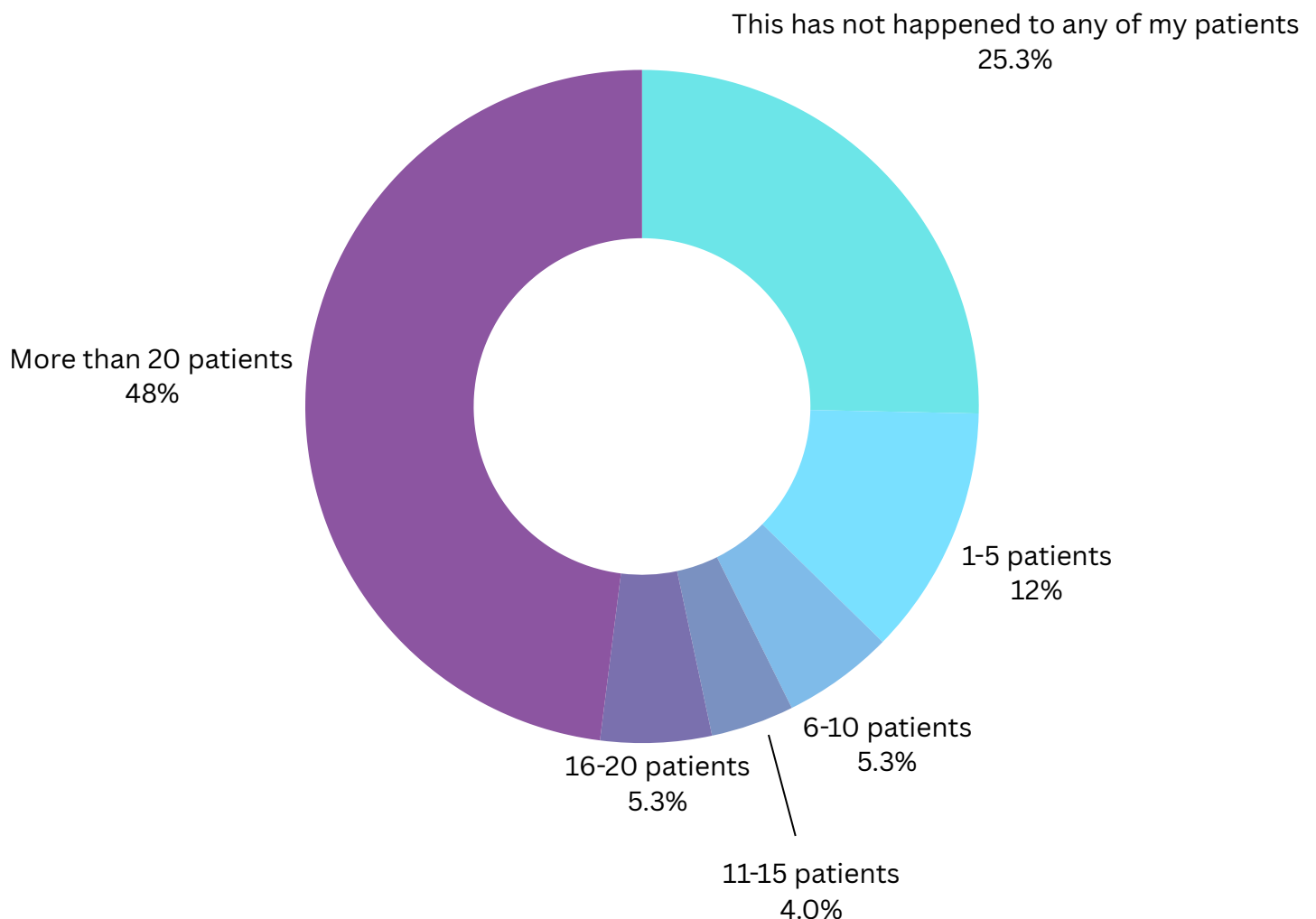

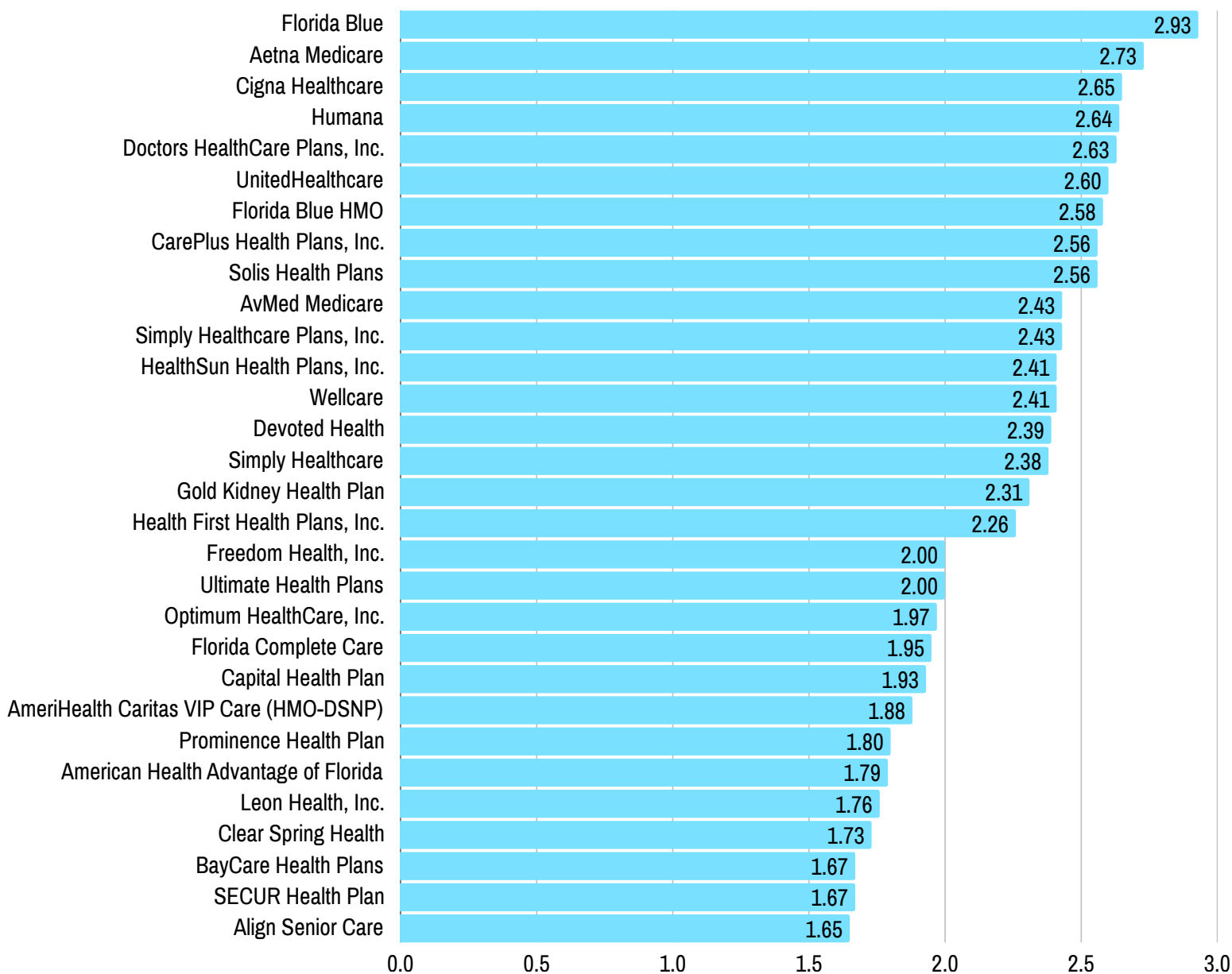

Please rate the adequacy of the physician network including access to primary care and specialists, for each of the following insurance companies that operate Medicare Advantage Plans in Florida:

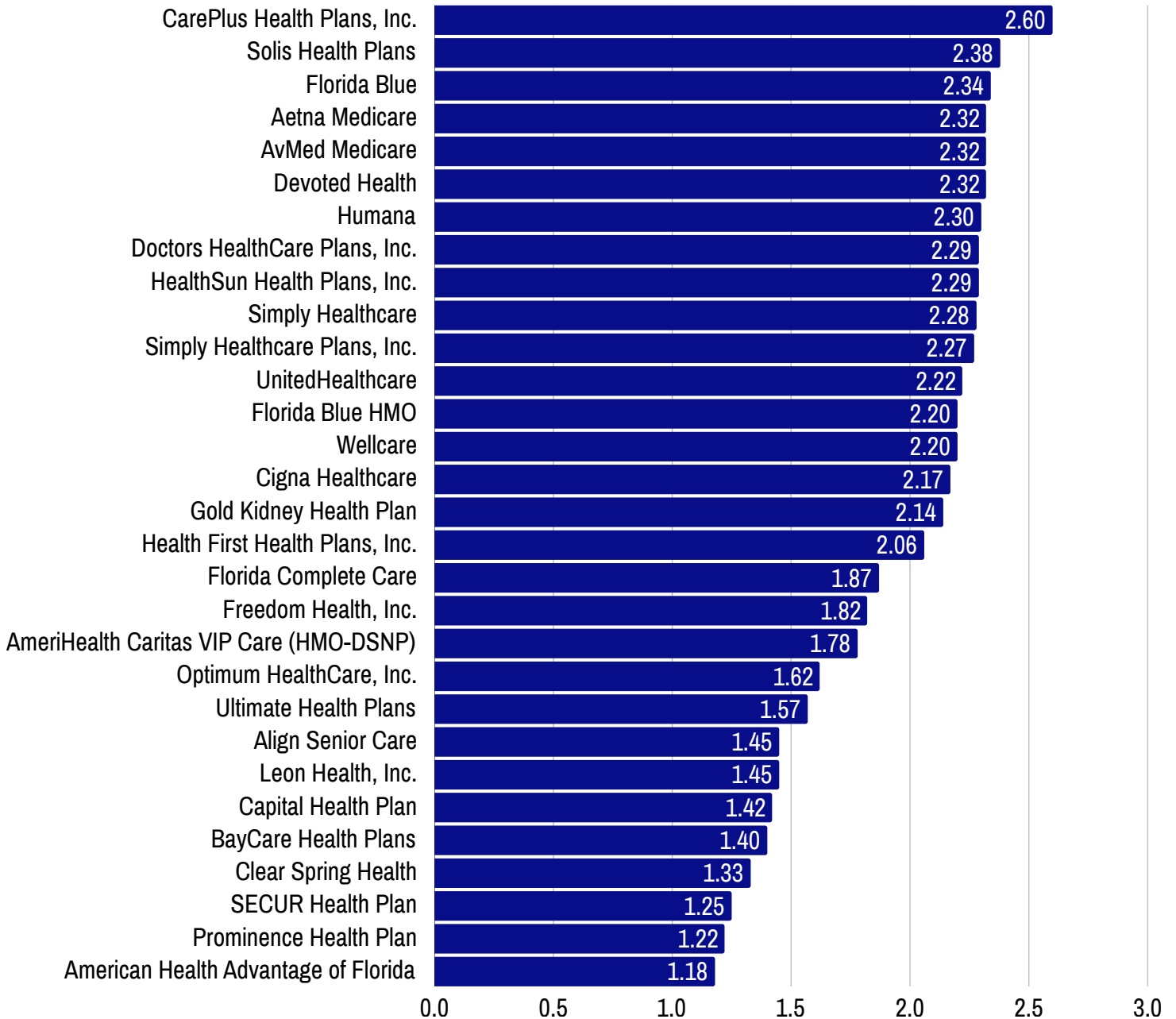

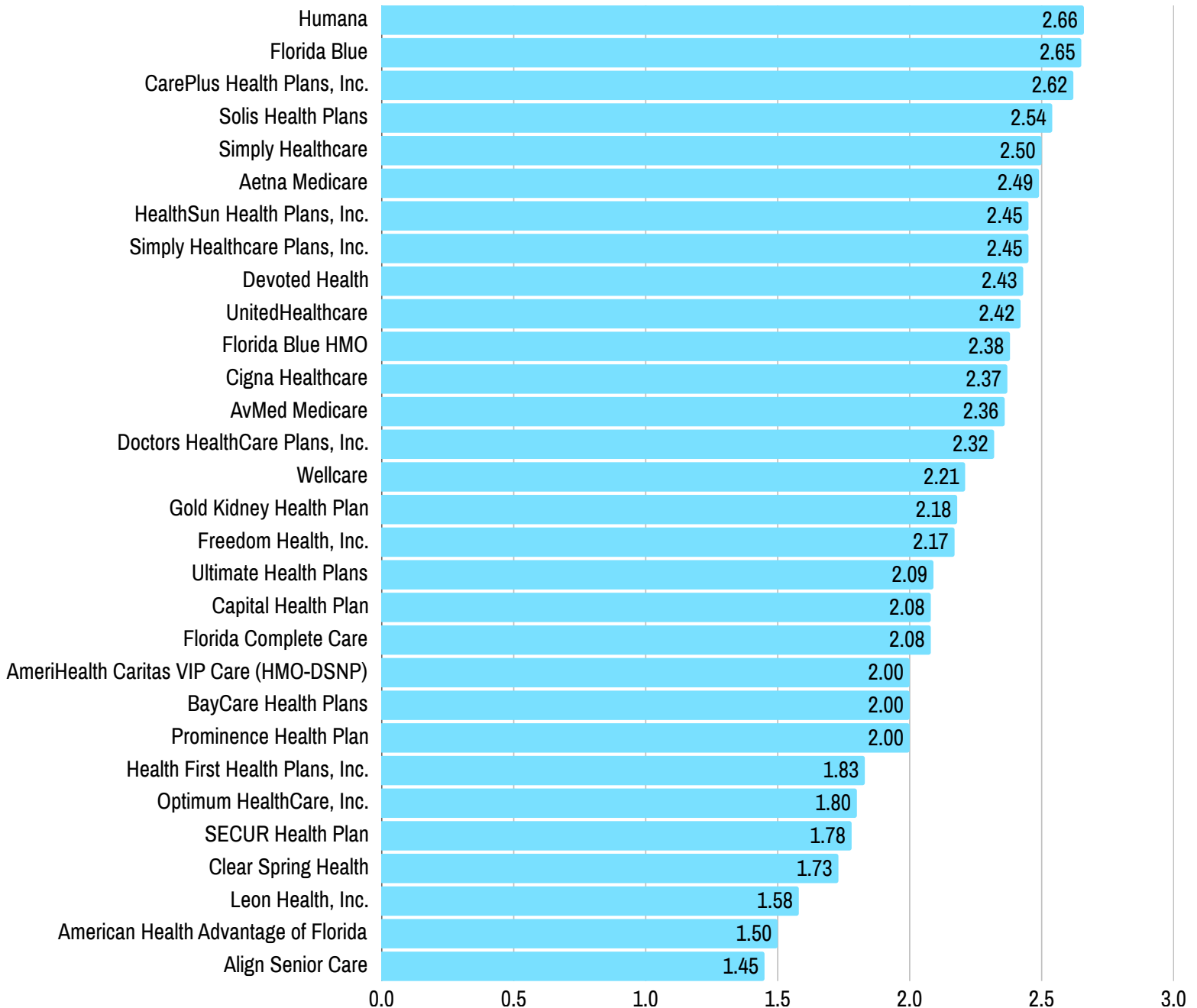

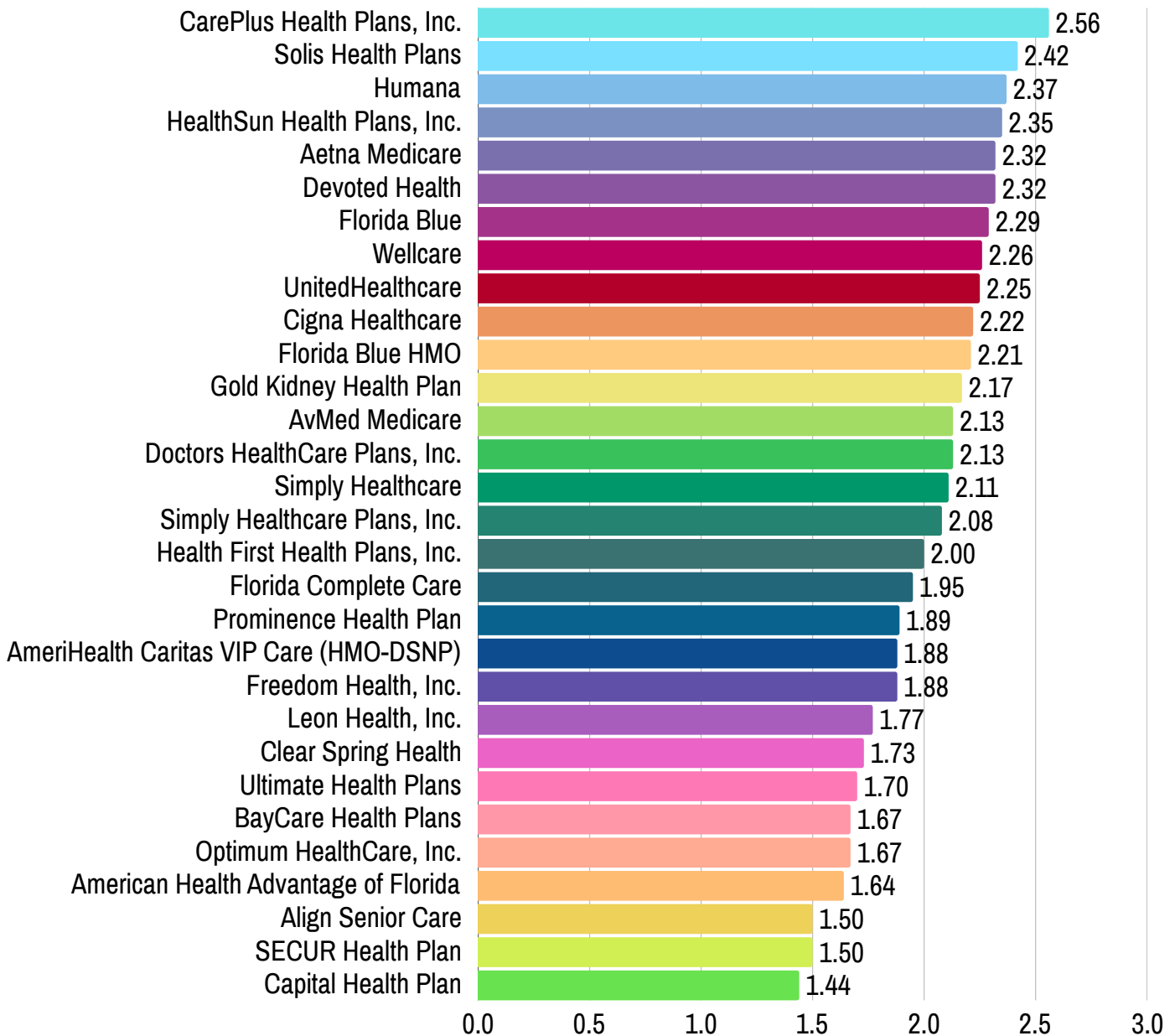
