

# WAND Student Scholarships

## Jo Saunders Student Scholarship

**AMOUNT:** \$500.00

### **UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Applicants must **be classified as first or second semester junior or second year in DT program** at the time of application for the scholarship.
2. Legal resident of Wisconsin attending school in Wisconsin or a reciprocal tuition institution. Student must qualify for in state tuition within the University of Wisconsin system.

## WAND Undergraduate Student Scholarship

**AMOUNT:** \$1,000.00

### **UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Applicants must be enrolled in an ACEND-accredited program at the time of application for the scholarship. Sophomores, juniors, seniors, second-year DT students and dietetic interns in the coordinated program or those not enrolled in graduate coursework are eligible.
2. Legal resident of Wisconsin attending school or internship in Wisconsin or a reciprocal tuition institution. Applicants must be WAND members.

## WAND Graduate Student Scholarship

**AMOUNT:** \$1,000.00

### **UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited graduate program at the time of application for the scholarship. Dietetic interns concurrently enrolled in graduate coursework are also eligible.
2. Legal resident of Wisconsin attending school or internship in Wisconsin or a reciprocal tuition institution. Applicants must be WAND members.

### **GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS (for all of the above scholarships):**

1. Documented financial need on application form.
2. Three (3) letters of recommendation, including a current faculty member. References must be received from three persons qualified to give pertinent information as to the applicant's character, scholastic ability and professional leadership qualities. These letters may be emailed or mailed directly to WAND by their authors, or uploaded by the applicant in the online application.
3. Transcript from all universities and institutions attended where five or more credit hours have been earned.
4. Completed applications must be uploaded by **February 1**. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the entire application is submitted completely—including transcript(s), three letters of recommendation, and resume—for consideration by the Scholarship Committee by February 1.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

1. Application, three letters of recommendation and transcripts are reviewed by each member of the Scholarship Committee.
2. Applications are scored by the committee and the scholarship recipients selected.
3. Letters are written to the scholarship recipients and other applicants by early March and payment mailed by August.
4. Certificates are presented to the scholarship recipients at the Wisconsin Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Annual Conference.
5. Scholarship awards may be received only once in each category. Applicants may apply for more than one scholarship at a time, but are eligible to receive only one per year.
