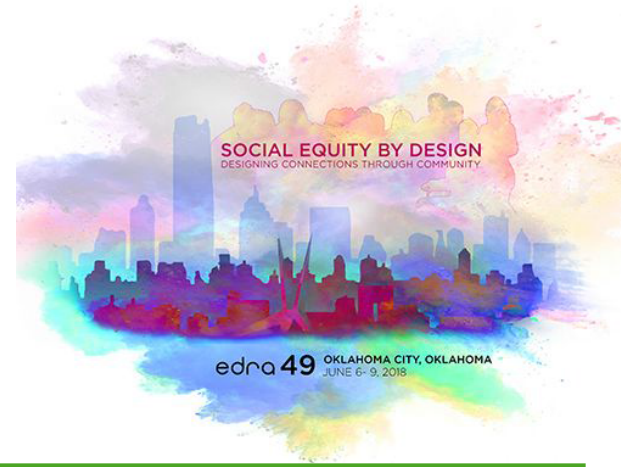

Graduate Student Workshop (June 6)

The Graduate Student Workshop is a daylong event held the Wednesday of EDRA's annual conference, designed to provide a forum for graduate students to present and discuss their ongoing research with senior mentors in environment-behavior design research.

Submission requirement: A short application form that includes a statement of interest, research summary, and a letter of endorsement from thesis advisor due **February 12, 2018**. Download the application form at the link: edra.site-ym.com/GraduateStudent.

Student Conference Scholarship

A limited number of conference scholarships in the form of reduced or complimentary conference registration and/or travel reimbursement are available every year to current EDRA student members who have been accepted to present at the EDRA conference. Scholarships range from \$100 to \$500 USD and are awarded each year to help offset the travel costs from students' academic institutions to the conference site. Second prize is a one-year EDRA student membership. All student award finalists merit recognition in EDRA publications.
