The Graduate Student Mentoring Workshop is a daylong event held the Wednesday of EDRA's annual conference, designed to provide a forum for graduate students to present and discuss their ongoing research with senior mentors in environment behavior design research.

Students interested in presenting their research during the workshop are requested to submit a short application form by January 21, 2019. Notices of acceptance will be issued by February 18, 2019. Those students wishing to register to attend as an observer can do so during the regular conference registration process.
