

Executive Summary

The 60th Board Meeting of the EPS Nuclear Physics Division was hosted by INFN Trieste in Italy between 29th and 30th October 2010. The meeting was attended by Prof. L. Cifarelli, president-elect of the EPS, who gave a presentation on the role and strategy of the EPS.

Professor Victor Zamfir (IFIN-HH, Bucharest, Romania) was elected to the position of "Chair Elect" with effect from January 2011. Douglas MacGregor was re-elected to act as Secretary until the end of 2012.

The terms of service of Matti Leino and Micha Hass expire at the end of 2010. The Division thanked both for their extensive contributions to the work of the Division. Matti Leino has provided leadership and direction by chairing the Division during 2008 and 2009 and continuity as past chair during the current year. Micha Hass has carried out sterling work on the preparations for the new Division thesis prize and has been a driving force in the success of the Nuclear Physics in Astrophysics conference series. Following a vote, the Division agreed to co-opt Eli Piasezky to join the board from January 2011.

The Division decided to nominate Nasser Kalantar as an observer to the European Research Committee on Few-Body Problems in Physics.

The Board accepted the bid from Portugal to organize the 6th conference on Nuclear Physics in Astrophysics between 19-24 May, 2013 in Lisbon trusting that the conference provides further stimulus for the field of nuclear astrophysics in Portugal.

The Division agreed that the IBA prize for Applied Nuclear Science and Nuclear Methods in Medicine will be presented at the First International Conference on Advances in Radioactive Isotope Science (ARIS - 2011), Leuven, Belgium, May 29 - June 3, 2011.
