

Executive summary of the 65th Board Meeting of the EPS Nuclear Physics Division held at Debrecen on the 19th and 20th April 2013

The 65th Board Meeting of the EPS Nuclear Physics Division was hosted by MTA Atomki, the Institute for Nuclear Research, Hungarian Academy of Sciences in Debrecen, Hungary, on the 19th and 20th April 2013.

The 2013 IBA Prize will be awarded during the International Nuclear Physics Conference, to be held in Florence on 2-7 June 2013.

The 2014 Lise Meitner Prize will be advertised in September 2013.

The 3rd European Energy Conference will take place in Budapest on 27-30 October 2013. Following a relevant invitation, the Nuclear Physics Board will be represented in the Energy Group Board, the first representative being Laszlo Csernai.

The Board supports the planned European Conference on Science and Technology for FAIR in 2014 and endorses it as a Divisional Conference.

The 3rd European Nuclear Physics Conference will be held in 2015, at a place to be decided later this year. Emphasis will be given in maximizing the participation of students and postdocs. The Ph.D. Prize for the best Ph.D. thesis in Europe in 2012-2015 will be awarded at that time.

The Board welcomed the two newly elected members, Faical Azaiez and Karlheinz Langanke. In addition, it co-opted as a member Dora Sohler, in order to fill the vacancy left by Zsolt Fulop, who will continue to serve the EPS as a member of its Executive Committee, and extended an invitation to Lola Cortina to join as a co-opted member in replacement of Jose Udias Moinelo, whose term expired in December 2012.
