

# EPS Award for Pre-university International Physics Competitions

The EPS Award for Pre-university physics competitions is open to the organisers of international physics competitions (Olympiads, tournaments and another international contests or other international events) promoting physics based on work of school students.

The grants are intended as sponsorship of an award to a student/team and/or to a teacher/supervisor.

## Conditions for participation

- Students must be enrolled in a European institution in a physics or physics related degree granting course at the Masters level or equivalent;
- Third cycle students are not eligible;
- Students can receive an EPS-USF only once;
- Students who have received grants from other bodies are eligible.
- Recipients should spend a period of at least three months at the university of their choice which should be in another European country from where they are enrolled.

## Selection procedure and criteria

- Applications will be reviewed based on the quality of proposal, quality of event, international character of the event, international reputation of the organizers, number of participants, number of countries participating in the event.
- The organisers must submit a request for the grant, describing the competition, providing the place and date of the competition, and describing the nature of the award they wish to attribute (student, teacher).
- The organisers should indicate the selection process for the award (e.g. jury members, faculty members, etc...), as well as an indication of the purpose of the award.

## Time Period

Applications are open throughout the year.
