

Statute of the EPS Nuclear Physics Division

(amended on 28 February 1973)

NAME OF THE DIVISION

This division of the [European Physical Society](#) shall be known as the Nuclear Physics Division.

SCOPE OF THE DIVISION

The object of the division shall be to assist the advancement and dissemination of knowledge of nuclear physics, which we define as the study of nuclei, their structure, disintegration, interactions and other properties and including the study of the constituent parts of the nucleus and their interactions with one another and with nuclei, and with atomic environment. The divisional activities will include the organisation of and approval of conferences and summer schools in this field of study and also furthering the exchange of scientists and students.

MEMBERSHIP OF THE DIVISION

Members of the Division shall be ordinary members of the EPS (Individual Ordinary Members, Constitution article 4a and 4c) and National Societies, Academies, Laboratories or Groups (Constitution Article 4b) or Fellows who have signified their intention to be members of the Division.

PARTICIPATION IN DIVISIONAL ACTIVITIES

Members of the adhering National Societies, Academies, Groups or Laboratories, referred to as Society members, can participate in all activities of the division, but shall not vote in the election of the divisional board and officers or any other matters requiring a divisional vote.

BOARD OF THE DIVISION

- (a) The board of the division shall have general charge of the activities of the division and of any other matters of direct interest to the division.
- (b) Members of the board must be individual ordinary members of the EPS (Constitution Article 4a or 4c) or fellows.
- (c) The board of the division shall consist of members and a chairman.
- (d) Ten members of the board shall be elected by the members of the division.
- (e) The board may co-opt at most ten additional members. (*)
- (f) The members of the board shall elect a chairman. They shall elect from amongst themselves a vice-chairman, a secretary and a treasurer.
- (g) No member of the division shall serve on the board for more than six consecutive years.
- (h) The election of the chairman, vice-chairman and secretary shall be confirmed by the EPS Executive Committee.

DIVISIONAL FUNDS

The Division may by vote of its members in any year request a contribution from its membership for its work. This income will remain at the disposal of the Division. The Board of the Division shall present to the Executive Committee an annual statement of its accounts.
