ESSKA Teaching Centre Accreditation - Criteria

To be eligible to apply for ESSKA Accreditation of your Teaching centre (T.C), the following criteria need to be fulfilled:

a. ESSKA Teacher

The T. C. must have two approved ESSKA Teachers (or [apply for the ESSKA Teacher Accreditation](#)) at the time of the Teaching Centre Accreditation application. Additionally, there should be at least 4 specialists at the institution ([see ESSKA Teacher Criteria](#)). Other clinicians responsible for teaching should have at least five years of experience.

b. Scientific Publications

The T.C should have a consistent line of relevant publications from the last five years in PubMed.

c. Clinical excellence

i. Advanced Surgery

The T.C must perform advanced surgery in one or more of the following areas: knee arthroscopy, knee arthroplasty, shoulder arthroscopy, ankle arthroscopy, hip arthroscopy. (areas of advanced surgery are indicated in application form)

ii. Number of Operative Procedures

The T.C. should have at least 500 operative cases per year

d. Reputation

The T.C. application must contain two reference letters from active (paid) ESSKA Members. These letters must be uploaded as a Pdf.

e. Language

The T.C's spoken languages must include English.
