



ESSKA Teacher Accreditation - Terms & Conditions

- [1] Any clinician can apply for accreditation by ESSKA. (See [ESSKA Teacher Criteria](#))
- [2] The clinician should apply by filling in the [online application form](#).
- [3] The application will be processed four times a year.
- [4] If the application is successful, the Teacher will receive a formal letter of Accreditation/Certificate and be published on ESSKA's website in the list of accredited ESSKA Teachers.
- [5] In accepting ESSKA's Accreditation, the Teacher must:
 - a. actively participate in the training of ESSKA Members by being a volunteering faculty member for at least one ESSKA's surgical-skills course per year, when applies.
 - b. participate in at least one ESSKA Congress within four years.
 - c. contribute at least one video to the [ESSKA Academy](#) every second year. [Video submission guidelines](#) are available on the Academy.
- [6] The Teacher should respond within 2 weeks to any request from ESSKA, when that request concerns a course, ESSKA Academy video submission or any other educational programme.
- [7] The Teacher must renew his/her accreditation every five years.
- [8] If the ESSKA Teacher fails in his/her obligations, ESSKA has the right to rescind that Teachers' Accreditation.
