



## ESSKA Teacher Accreditation - Criteria

To be eligible to apply for ESSKA Teacher Accreditation, the following criteria need to be fulfilled:

### a. ESSKA Membership

The ESSKA Teacher must be an active (paid) ESSKA member for at least two years prior to the application.

### b. Clinical Excellence

The ESSKA Teacher must:

- i. have five years of clinical practice in sports traumatology with arthroscopic surgical or arthroplasty activity.
- ii. have participated as an instructor in minimum 2 surgical-skills courses (ESSKA courses or any other courses) within arthroscopy or arthroplasty.
- iii. have specialist recognition (surgery / accident surgery / orthopaedics) (areas of advanced surgery are indicated in the application)

### c. Scientific excellence

The ESSKA Teacher must have at least two publications in MEDLINE on arthroscopic or arthroplasty topics within the last five years.

### d. Reputation

The ESSKA Teacher application must have at least one reference from an active (paid) ESSKA Member. (Reference letter required and must be uploaded as pdf)

### e. Language

The ESSKA Teachers' spoken languages must include English.
