FOURTH AMENDMENT TO MANDATORY FACE COVERING ORDERS OF MAY 18, 2020, JUNE 10, 2021, JULY 6, 2021, AND AUGUST 4, 2021

Based on discussions with the Fairfax Health Department and per CDC guidelines, the courthouse mask directive is amended as follows:
