OVERALL EVALUATION

The Committee was very impressed with Mr. Somech and viewed him as qualified for the Circuit Court Bench. Mr. Somech demonstrated a sincere interest in a position as a Judge and will benefit from further service to the Fairfax Bar Association and continued work in the Fairfax legal community.
