Award Category

1. Educator of the Year
 - a. From a degree-granting institution
 - b. From a non-degree granting institution

Nomination Guidelines

1. Member institutions may submit up to **two** nominations.
2. Member institutions are responsible for ensuring that the nominee (or an alternate recipient) is present to accept the award.
3. Both the nominator and nominee must be affiliated with an institution that is current in FAPSC membership requirements.
4. Students are not eligible to make nominations.
5. Nominees may only be nominated for one category.

Award Category and Criteria

Educator of the Year

Purpose

The Educator of the Year Award honors faculty who exemplify the highest standards of teaching, scholarship, and service.

Eligibility

The nominee must be affiliated with an institution that is current in FAPSC membership requirements.

Number of Awards

- One winner will be awarded from a degree-granting institution.
- One winner will be awarded from a non-degree granting institution

Criteria

The faculty member must have demonstrated:

- Exceptional commitment to mentoring and teaching excellence.
- Dedication to scholarship and self-development.
- Outstanding service to the institution and community.
