



## 2020 Award Categories and Nomination Guidelines

### Award Category

1. Graduate of the Year
  - a. Graduating from a degree-granting program
  - b. Graduating from a non-degree granting program

### Nomination Guidelines

1. Member institutions may submit up to **two** nominations.
2. Member institutions are responsible for ensuring that the nominee (or an alternate recipient) is present to accept the award.
3. Both the nominator and nominee must be affiliated with an institution that is current in FAPSC membership requirements.
4. Students are not eligible to make nominations.
5. Nominees may only be nominated for one category.

## Award Category and Criteria

### Graduate of the Year Award

#### ***Purpose***

The Graduate of the Year Award honors a student who has not only demonstrated academic excellence, but also made meaningful contributions to his or her institution and community.

#### ***Eligibility***

The nominee must have graduated from a FAPSC member institution within the past three years.

#### ***Number of Awards***

- ❖ One winner will be awarded from a degree-granting program.
- ❖ One winner will be awarded from a non-degree granting program.

#### ***Criteria***

The nominee must have demonstrated:

- ❖ The ability to perform, achieve, and/or excel in scholastic activities.
- ❖ Extraordinary commitment to improving his or her institution and community.
- ❖ *Optional (used in the event of a tie):* Perseverance in overcoming adversity.
