- Must be willing to serve in a leadership role at the Chapter, State or Executive level following the leadership training for a minimum of 1 year.

- Candidate's tenure as FPA member and any leadership positions previously held within FPA or otherwise
- Written responses to questions posed in this application
- Other considerations that indicate that a candidate is uniquely qualified to serve as a leader
