Why PDF/A??

# International PDF/A Committee

- Future feature capabilities moving forward
  - Version 4
  - Will focus on current version, knowing not all entities need all features (e.g., FCTC prohibits embedding of files)
- Looking to simplify by eliminating subtypes “a,” “b,” “u”
- PDF/A will be PDF/A

# FCTC Status

- Working issue from multiple fronts
  - Attorney education (other filer education in the future)
  - Electronic-Filing Portal
  - Clerk CMS processing
  - Judicial Viewer
- A transition process
  - 5-year process acknowledged (note, we're 2 years into the process)
  - Hope that published standard would lead to vendors moving forward through upgrades
  - Future time requirement possible
  - Key may be to show progress
- Funding
  - No funding in place
  - Total costs have not been determined
  - Hope this will be minimized / met through pushing the standard forward with no deadline
- Outstanding PDF/A issues distributed to various workgroups for resolution

# The Portal Proposal

- Will receive documents as
  - PDF
  - PDF/A
  - Word
  - WordPerfect formats
- Will convert documents to format requested by each clerk's office
  - PDF
  - PDF/A
  - TIFF



# CMS Vendor Status

- Clericus
  - Needed upgrade to DMS. Will include PDF capabilities along with 64 bit, etc.
  - Counties have agreed to purchase the upgrade
  - Evaluating all aspects of processing PDF/A
- Tyler Odyssey
  - Capable of processing TIFF, intelligent PDF and PDF/A
  - Can convert to PDF/A
  - Working towards implementation of standards

# CMS Vendor Status (cont.)

- Equivant ShowCase
  - Evaluating requirements at both vendor and advisory group levels
  - See this as a significant development effort
  - Nothing being developed pending clarification
- Pioneer Technology Group Benchmark
  - No requests to date to implement processing of PDF/A although requests expected in near future
  - In process of updating controls to handle intelligent PDF and PDF/A
  - Lack specific requirements from customers

# CMS Vendor Status (cont.)

- County specific
  - Volusia can accept and process intelligent PDF documents (have not specifically tested PDF/A)
- CSI (TrakMan - DMS)
  - Processes and stores PDF and PDF/A
  - Time stamps PDF/A
  - Can version digitally signed documents

# Redaction Vendors

- CSI Intellidact
  - Redaction processing of PDF/A documents available as a paid update
  - Resultant PDF/A is intelligent document with full redaction
- Mentis aiRedact
  - Can process PDF or TIFF which can be converted to searchable PDF
  - Waiting on specifications and direction for PDF/A

# Group Discussion

- This is not simple, a lot of issues to be resolved
- FCCC Technology Strategic Planning Committee Working on Requirements and Hurdles
- Further clarification of open issues needed from the FCTC
- Incremental progress: first PDF, then PDF/A?
- CAPS viewers must be brought along at the same time
