## Martin County Clerk Appointed to Constitution Revision Commission

Tallahassee, FL— The Honorable Carolyn Timmann, Martin County Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller, was appointed to the Constitution Revision Commission by Senate President Joe Negron this week to serve as one of 37 commissioners during the historic process held every 20 years. Commission members will be responsible for reviewing the state's current constitution and proposing amendments for voter's consideration on the state's 2018 general election ballot.

In Timmann's appointment letter, Senator Joe Negron wrote, "The people of our State are fortunate to have the benefit of your ability in this important and historic role. Thank you for your willingness to commit your time and expertise to serve the people of Florida."

"Public service has been the cornerstone of my professional career, and as a constitutional officer, I am extremely mindful of the importance of this process and look forward to serving the people of Florida in this capacity." Clerk Timmann commented

"Carolyn's vast experience within Florida's public sector, including her role as Martin County Clerk and Comptroller, will serve her well in helping the Constitution Revision Commission shape Florida's future," stated Nassau County Clerk and Florida Court Clerk & Comptroller President John Crawford.

Clerk Timmann was first elected to the office of Martin County Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller in 2013 and was subsequently re-elected in 2016. She has served on the constitutionally established Florida Taxation and Budget Reform Commission (TBRC) in 2008 and currently serves as the Governor's appointee representing the Florida Clerks on the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Information Systems Council (CJJIS) through FDLE.
