**Clerks' and Comptrollers' Offices Impacted by Hurricane Michael**

Tallahassee, Fla. – The majority of the 12 counties in the Second and Fourteenth Judicial Circuits were heavily impacted by Hurricane Michael last week. These counties continue to deal with many issues, including efforts to restore power. As a result, many of the clerks' offices in these counties are currently in recovery mode and are not open; however, plans are underway for all offices to open by next week.

To support offices heavily impacted by Hurricane Michael, FCCC is serving as the media's point of contact for inquiries to clerks and comptrollers in the following counties\*: Bay, Calhoun, Gulf, Holmes, Jefferson and Liberty.
