FCCC statement regarding the passage of Amendment 10

Tallahassee, Fla. – The Honorable Sharon R. Bock, Esq., FCCC President and Palm Beach County Clerk and Comptroller, offers the following statement regarding the passage of Amendment 10:

“Constitutional officers serve a critical function in our state. Florida’s clerks and comptrollers are grateful to our state’s voters for approving Amendment 10, and for recognizing the importance of preserving their right to elect local constitutional officers.

“Florida Court Clerks & Comptrollers worked closely with key partners throughout our state in support of Amendment 10 to guarantee the check and balance provided by independently elected clerks and comptrollers, sheriffs, tax collectors, property appraisers and supervisors of election. That independence is vital to our state’s governance, and voters clearly agreed.

“We turn now to the important task of working with local governments to serve Floridians and continuing to provide them with the important services they have come to expect from our offices.”
