Clerks Planning for Driver License Reinstatement Events Between March 29 – April 12

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Today, Florida Court Clerks & Comptrollers (FCCC) announced plans for local Clerk of Court offices to hold coordinated Operation Green Light events within a two-week period, from Saturday, March 29 – Saturday, April 12, 2025. Participating offices will hold events one or more days during this timeframe.

The annual driver license reinstatement events provide customers with an opportunity to pay overdue court-ordered obligations, while saving on additional fees.
