What information do I need to submit to FES?

School principals, District Administrators or teachers should send the following (3) items to the Florida Engineering Society: Amanda Hudson, ahudson@fleng.org

1. Full name of the eligible student with academic grade level (Junior, Senior)
2. Name of the school and school address which the industry certifications should be mailed to.
3. Proof of students End of Course Assessment scores over the course of three academic years that add up to or are greater than a total score of 19.

Do students need to attend a PLTW certified school to earn a FES industry certification?
