Summary of Recommendations

- In a report from the Edmond J. Safra Center for Ethics with support from the Rockefeller Foundation, it is recommended that economic mobilization be linked to an ambitious program of testing, tracing and supported isolation.
- It is aimed at delivering 5 million tests/day by early June increasing to 20 million tests/day by July to remobilize the economy.
- This will require testing innovation.

Four Phases

- Phase 1 – Stabilize Essential Sectors (May)
- Phase 2 –Expand Essential Workers (July)
- Phase 3 – End Collective Stay-at-Home (Late July)
- Phase 4 – Full Pandemic Resilience (August)

Progression from one phase to another is dependent on 3 factors:

- Assessment of declining case rate
- Assessment of sufficient hospital capacity
- Assessment of sufficient testing capacity
- * Continue to work to develop therapeutics and a vaccine
