COVID-19 Coronavirus Outbreak – Effects on FNA Programming

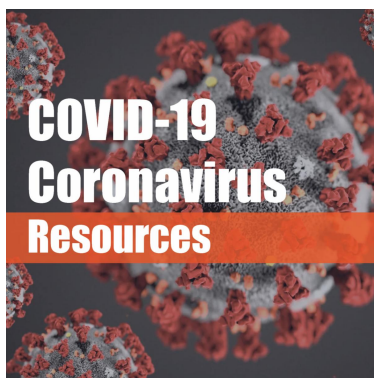
