The Awards

This awards program recognizes innovative and outstanding achievements in water efficiency throughout Florida.

Entry Guidelines

- Each entry must be for a project or program implemented within the last three years which has not already won this award.
- **Submittal Requirements:**
One entry form (this page) must be completed for each project or program. Print entry forms must be accompanied by a CD containing the following **Electronic Documentation** (may place multiple entries on one CD):
 - A short abstract (300 words or less, in Microsoft Word) describing the project or program and how it meets the *evaluation criteria* (see right column).
 - Three to ten images representative of the project or program, for possible publication or use in the awards presentation. Suggested format is JPEG.
 - Any other supporting information.
- If your entry contains items that cannot be photographed or scanned for inclusion on the CD, mail them with the entry package.
- Mail each completed entry form with the appropriate entry fee and supporting documentation.
- For return of entry materials, include a stamped self-addressed envelope. Otherwise materials will not be returned.
- Entries will be marked “incomplete” unless the Submittal Requirements are met. Incomplete entries will not be refunded
- Entries are to be postmarked by Friday, September 30, 2016.
