

<u>TITLE OF THE RESOLUTION</u>	To read the budget by title only at the public hearing
<u>STATUTORY REFERENCE</u>	NJSA 40A:4-8
<u>INSTANCE WHEN YOU WOULD TYPICALLY USE</u>	During the public hearing on the budget
<u>LIMITATIONS</u>	At least one week prior to the date of the hearing, a complete copy of the approved budget, as advertised shall be posted in a public place where public notices are customarily posted, in the case of a county budget, in the county court house, and in the case of a municipal budget, in the principal municipal building, but if there is no such building, then in such public place as notices are usually posted. In all cases the budget must be posted in the public library.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A:4-8 provides that the budget be read by title only at the time of public hearing if a resolution is passed by not less than a majority of the full governing body, providing that at least one week prior to the date of hearing a complete copy of the approved budget as advertised has been posted in the Municipal Building, the local public library, and copies have been made available by the Clerk to persons requesting them; and

WHEREAS, these conditions have been met;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Jerseyville, in the County of Jersey, State of New Jersey, that the budget shall be read by title only.
