For fresh produce farms, FDA's Food Safety Modernization Act Produce Safety Rule sets mandatory federal standards for growing, harvesting, packing, and holding produce. Most produce farms will be affected by this Rule. This training will help growers understand the new requirements and provide the information needed to comply with the Rule.

### Featuring classroom and on-farm learning

This 1.5 day workshop will be taught by instructors from around the South with experience working with small and medium size vegetable growers. Along with the traditional Produce Safety Alliance training, both days will feature farm tours of the compost operation, the organic vegetable farm, and the livestock production areas.
