

### Director of Development, Georgia State University Perimeter College

# **Description**

# **Job Description**

The position is responsible for planning and implementing fund raising activities associated with University-wide priorities. The position is directly responsible for identifying major gifts prospects; developing and executing long and short-term strategies in the cultivation and solicitation of these prospects and working collaboratively with a team in the solicitation of corporate and foundation gifts. The Director will manage a pool of approximately 150 prospects and spend at least 70% of their time in meetings with these prospects.

#### Responsibilities

- Cultivate, solicit, and steward prospects (both individual and Corporate/Foundation) at the \$25,000 or greater level. Coordinate with department chairs and faculty to develop proposals to the private sector. Complete 15 or more face to face visits per month.
- Manage a portfolio of 150+ prospects and donors annually. Work to continuously add prospects to the Perimeter College major gift pipeline.
- Work with Perimeter College Scholarship Team to insure all qualified scholarships are awarded and donors stewarded.
- Assist with events such as stewardship programs and departmental alumni functions.
- Work with development personnel to produce database reports that support the fundraising activities of Perimeter College.
- Develop long and short-term priorities and funding plans with Senior Director of Development, AVP, VP and other members of the University leadership.
- Manage the GPC/DeKalb College Retiree Association which includes meeting/event logistics, newsletter development and implementing all Perimeter College retiree fundraising plans.

### **Oualifications**

Bachelor's degree and two years of experience in face-to-face solicitation of gifts of \$25,000 or more; or a combination of education and related experience.

- Demonstrated success at raising funds by developing and implementing cultivation and solicitation plans.
