The Hispanic Bar Association of the District of Columbia ("HBA-DC") is pleased to recommend Alfred Belcuore for an Associate Judge vacancy in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia. We believe, based on our research and deliberations, including an interview with Mr. Belcuore, that his work as an Associate Judge would be a significant contribution to the Superior Court.

The HBA-DC undertakes a careful review of individuals who seek its endorsement. We ensure that candidates for endorsement meet the letter and the spirit of our endorsement policy, which includes such criteria as demonstrated professional qualifications and personal traits.

On the basis of that review, we believe that Alfred Belcuore's contributions as an adjunct law professor of trial practice at Georgetown University Law Center provide the requisite scholarly experience to merit our support. Moreover, Mr. Belcuore's experience as President of the Federal Bar Association and his participation in various D.C. Bar task forces and committees demonstrate administrative and organizational talent. Mr. Belcuore's 25 years of trial practice, which include 25 jury trials and 70 appeals, demonstrate a strong background to be a successful jurist.

Other significant factors encourage our support as well. The HBA-DC highly values a demonstrated commitment to the D.C. community as well as to the rights or advancement of the Hispanic community or other historically disadvantaged groups. Mr. Belcuore's support of the Women's Bar Association and of the Southern Poverty Law Center are
