

## YOUR TRANSPORTATION CONNECTION TO BALTIMORE

With its central location on the U.S. East Coast, Baltimore is easy to reach by your choice of transportation - highway, rail, air, and even water! (And within four hours or less of such other major cities as New York City, Philadelphia, and Washington, D.C.) Here's all the transportation information you need to plan your trip here.

### AIRPORTS

- **Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI):** 800-435-9294 or 410-859-7111  
BWI is located 10 miles south of the city, about 15-20 minutes, and is the primary airport for travelers to Baltimore. Airport transfers to Baltimore or Washington, DC are available via shuttle bus, taxi, Light Rail, Amtrak and limousine service. Special services for groups include two hospitality counters with staff to meet and assist visitors, stands for welcome signs at the main escalators, small meeting space, business center and banquet facilities.

### BWI AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

- **Light Rail:** \$1.60 one way/\$3.50 round trip. Light rail stop "University Center/Baltimore Street" is 3 blocks/3-5 minute walk from hotel. Exit hotel and turn right onto Baltimore Street. Walk 3 blocks to Howard Street; the stop is on the corner of Baltimore and Howard Streets next to First Mariner Arena. Trains leave every 8 minutes. Every other train goes to BWI airport. The trains are marked "Cromwell" and BWI". Approximately 20 minute train ride one way. Hours of operation: Monday-Saturday 6am-11pm. Sunday and Holidays 11am-7pm.
- **Super Shuttle:** \$15.00 one way. From hotel, shuttle departs our hotel to BWI every 20 and 40 minutes after each hour (i.e. 6:20, 6:40, 7:20, 7:40 Shuttle makes 5 stops on the way to BWI.)
- **Taxi:** \$30.00 approximately one way. Available outside hotel entrance.
- **Executive Shuttle:** \$40.00 one way. Ask a guest service representative for assistance.

## **BALTIMORE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS**

**Penn Station**, located at 1500 N. Charles Street in Baltimore. Trains arrive and depart from Penn Station daily; Penn Station offers enclosed waiting areas, paid short-term and long-term parking, a restaurant, snack bar, taxi, and transit service.

**Amtrak** trains run 24 hours a day, seven days a week, connecting Baltimore to cities along the Northeast Corridor. Amtrak also runs to BWI. For fares and schedules, call 1-800-872-7245.

**MARC Commuter Trains** operate weekdays from Baltimore to Washington, D.C. and depart from Penn Station. For fares and schedules, call 1-888-218-2267 or 410-539-5000.

**The Mass Transit Administration (MTA)** operates bus, Metro, Light Rail, and MARC train services. The local bus system, which operates seven days a week, covers the downtown neighborhoods and parts of Baltimore's suburbs.

**Baltimore's Metro System** operates 7 days a week and runs from Owings Mills in Baltimore County to Johns Hopkins Hospital, downtown.

**The Light Rail** system also operates seven days a week and runs from Hunt Valley in Baltimore County to the Cromwell Station in Anne Arundel County, as well as from Penn Station to BWI.

### **Water Transportation**

Did you know Baltimore has the oldest public water-based transportation system in the U.S.? So what better way to cruise the city than to hop aboard one of our water shuttles to travel around Baltimore's Inner Harbor as well as Little Italy, Fell's Point, Canton and Fort McHenry. On a warm day, it's the perfect way to get around the city. Call ahead for seasonal schedules or group tours.

# MAJOR HIGHWAY DIRECTIONS TO THE LORD BALTIMORE HOTEL

## **From Points South (Washington, D.C. - Richmond - Virginia Beach)**

Take I-95 North into Baltimore. Take Exit 53 (I-395 North). I-395 North will become Howard Street. Follow Howard Street to Baltimore Street and turn right. Follow two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From Points North (New York - New Jersey - Philadelphia)**

Take I-95 South into Baltimore. Go through the Fort McHenry Tunnel. Take the second exit after the tunnel (Exit 53 - I-395 North). I-395 North will become Howard Street. Follow Howard Street to Baltimore Street and turn right. Follow two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From I-70**

Take I-70 to I-695 South (Marked Glen Burnie). Follow I-695 and exit onto I-95 North. Follow I-95 North into Baltimore. Take Exit 53 (I-395 North). I-395 North will become Howard Street. Follow Howard Street to Baltimore Street and turn right. Follow two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From I-83**

Take I-83 South to the end and turn right onto Fayette Street. Go nine (9) blocks to Liberty Street and turn left. Make next left onto Baltimore Street and next left at Hanover Street. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From BWI Airport**

Take I-295 North into Baltimore. Once inside the city limits, I-295 will become Russell Street. Once Russell Street crosses Pratt Street it becomes Paca Street. Stay on Paca Street and turn right on Baltimore Street. Follow Baltimore Street two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From Annapolis**

Take Route 50 to Route 97. Follow Route 97 to I-695 (towards Towson). Take I-695 to I-295 North (towards Baltimore). Once inside the city limits, I-295 will become Russell Street. Once Russell Street crosses Pratt Street it becomes Paca Street. Stay on Paca Street and turn right on Baltimore Street. Follow Baltimore Street two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **From Route 40 East**

Route 40 East will become Pulaski Highway. Pulaski Highway will become Orleans Street, and Orleans Street becomes Franklin Street. Once you cross the overpass, follow Franklin Street to Cathedral Street. Cathedral Street will become Liberty Street. Follow Liberty Street to Baltimore Street and make a left onto Baltimore Street. Make the next left onto Hanover Street. Hotel entrance is on the right.

### **From Route 40 West**

Take Route 40 West to Edmondson Avenue. At the cemetery, Edmondson Avenue will become Mulberry Street. Follow Mulberry Street to Cathedral Street. Cathedral Street will become Liberty Street. Follow Liberty Street to Baltimore Street and make a left onto Baltimore Street. Make the next left onto Hanover Street. Hotel entrance is on the right.

### **From National Airport**

Take Route 1 South. Follow Route 1 South until you reach I-495/I-95. Take I-495/I-95 North towards Baltimore. Follow I-95 North to Exit 53 (I-395 North). I-395 North will become Howard Street. Follow Howard Street to Baltimore Street and turn right onto Baltimore Street. Follow Baltimore Street two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

### **From Dulles International Airport**

Take the Dulles Access Road East to I-495 North (Washington Beltway). Follow I-495 to I-95 North. Take I-95 North into Baltimore. Take Exit 53 (I-395 North). I-395 North will become Howard Street. Follow Howard Street to Baltimore Street and turn right. Follow two (2) blocks to Hanover Street and turn left. Hotel entrance is on the right.

## **PARKING**

### **Self Parking:**

Located just 2 blocks from the hotel. The garage is located on the left side of West Fayette Street approximately 50 yards west of the corner of Park Avenue and West Fayette.

### **Valet Parking:**

Located at the main entrance of The Hotel on North Hanover Street. Due to our large turnout, please be patient you may have a wait time for Valet service.
