

The Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Professionalism Committee seeks nominations for the 2019 Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Professionalism Awards

The Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Professionalism Awards are presented by the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit's Committee on Professionalism. Two awards will be presented to recognize one attorney currently in private practice and one attorney currently in government practice. The awards were established to annually recognize individuals who consistently demonstrate honesty, integrity, fairness, courtesy, and an abiding sense of responsibility to comply with the standards and rules of professionalism in the practice of law. To be eligible for nomination, a candidate must be a member of the Florida Bar practicing within the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit for at least fifteen (15) years.

The nomination should also demonstrate how the nominee exhibits the highest professional standards in his or her everyday life. Any specific, recent, extraordinary examples of professionalism should be noted in the nomination. The committee encourages nominations from co-workers, the judiciary and opposing counsel.

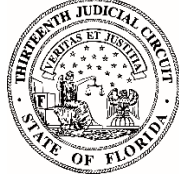
