



2019 Scholarship Application

Established by the Houston Human Resource Management Association

HR Houston annually provides two scholarship awards to support its members who are pursuing a degree to advance their HR careers --

- A \$2,500 award to an active HR Houston Professional, General or Student Member who is enrolled for at least 9 hours in a Bachelor's degree program in Human Resources at a Houston-area university supported by HR Houston's University Liaison Committee
- A \$2,500 award to an active HR Houston Professional, General or Student Member who is enrolled for at least 6 hours in a Master's degree program in Human Resources at a Houston-area university supported by HR Houston's University Liaison Committee

Basis for Selection

Award #1

- Current HR Houston Professional, General or Student Membership in good standing
- Completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours, and currently enrolled for at least 9 hours
- Working towards a Bachelor's degree in Human Resources (either as a major if the university offers an HR degree; or at minimum, a Business degree with a concentration and/or minor in HR)
- Intends to enroll at a Houston-area university that is supported by HR Houston's University Liaison Committee for a minimum of 9 hours for the summer or fall 2019 semester/quarter
- Members of HR Houston's Board of Directors and members of the University Liaison Committee are not eligible

Award #2

- Current HR Houston Professional, General or Student Membership in good standing
- Completed a minimum of 6 credit hours towards a Master's degree; and currently enrolled for at least 6 hours
- Working towards a Master's degree in Human Resources (either as a major if the university offers an HR degree; or at minimum, a Business degree with a concentration and/or minor in HR)
- Intends to enroll at a Houston-area university that is supported by HR Houston's University Liaison Committee for a minimum of 6 hours for the summer or fall 2019 semester/quarter
- Members of HR Houston's Board of Directors and members of the University Liaison Committee are not eligible

How to apply

1. Complete all blanks and provide all requested information. Place no personal or university identification on any page except where requested. The committee for judging purposes will assign you a unique identification number.
2. Submit an official copy of your most recent college transcript with the application.
3. Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a professor, chapter advisor, or employer.
4. Provide a statement of your interest in pursuing a career in Human Resources, including the importance of education and degree to support that interest. The statement should be at least (1) page not to exceed (2) pages, typed. The winners' statement may be published in the HR Houston news feed.
5. Submit a copy of your most current resume.
6. Your completed application and supporting documents must be received by FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2019 at 3:00 pm CT
7. Winners will be announced in Spring 2019 and the award presented upon receipt of documentation of enrollment.
