



Pharmacy Student Travel Grant *Compounders on Capitol Hill - 2019*

Through the generosity of donors to our **Fund-the-Future** campaign the IACP Foundation will be offering **up to two (2)** pharmacy students a travel grant to attend the International Academy of Compounding Pharmacists' annual meeting -- *Compounders on Capitol Hill* -- on May 18-21, 2019, in Washington, DC.

What's Available?

Travel grants, up to \$2,500 each, will cover the following expenses:

- Meeting registration for one student to attend *Compounders on Capitol Hill 2019* – \$ 150
- "Hill Day" registration for one student – \$ 300
- Rx Mixer attendance and dinner, Sunday, May 19, 2019 – \$ 150
- Five (5) nights of hotel accommodations – \$ 1,000
- Funds to cover meals and travel not covered by registration and incidentals – \$ 900 (paid after attendance)

When Can I Apply?

Applications for the IACP Foundation travel grant for the *2019 Compounders on Capitol Hill* conference must be submitted **no later than March 6, 2019**. The IACP Foundation will review all complete applications and select up to two (2) pharmacy students to receive a travel grant. The decisions of the Foundation are final.

Students who have applied will be notified of the Foundation's decision by **early April 2019**.

How Do I Apply?

Recipients of a travel grant for attendance to the *2019 Compounders on Capitol Hill annual meeting and participation in "Hill Day"* will be selected by the IACP Foundation based on the following applicant criteria:

All applicants must:

1. Fill out the *Pharmacy Student Travel Grant Application – Compounders on Capitol Hill - 2019*. The application can be found [here](#). Incomplete applications will be summarily disqualified from consideration.
2. Be currently enrolled in an accredited college of pharmacy.
3. IACP Student Membership is encouraged.
4. Be able to attend IACP Foundation and IACP Board meetings on Saturday, May 18, 2019 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM EDT.
5. Be able to attend all scheduled activities, including CE programs and exhibitor experiences.
6. Participate in Congressional Hill visits on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM EDT.
7. Preferably be nominated by a current IACP member who plans to attend *Compounders on Capitol Hill - 2019*.
8. Submit a letter of support. This can be the same individual who nominated the applicant.
9. Previous grant awardees are encouraged to re-apply; however, first time applicants will be given precedence to encourage award diversity.
10. In the event the selected *Pharmacy Student Grant* recipient is unable to attend all events required, the full amount of the travel grant may not be paid out to the recipient.
