Exhibit Rules and Regulations

Please read carefully. All exhibitors must adhere to the following Exhibit Rules & Regulations and all guidelines in this prospectus, all of which are incorporated by reference as part of the Exhibitor Application/Contract. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that all booth staff is aware of and adheres to these rules. IASIU reserves the right to interpret and make final decisions regarding all rules & regulations. In applying for exhibit space, exhibitors agree to abide by the following regulations:

Admission Policy

Admission to the Exhibition Hall is by name badge only. Exhibit booth personnel must show an official IASIU exhibitor badge in order to gain access to the hall during installation, exhibit or dismantling hours. Independent contractor personnel, hired by an exhibitor to install and dismantle their display, should possess identification that they are employed by the independent contractor. If independent contractors do not possess proper identification, they must obtain a name badge at the exhibitor registration desk. All registered exhibit personnel must wear their official IASIU name badge at all times when working the booth. This regulation applies to individuals dispensing information about the organization's products, or services, as well as individuals contracted by the organization to provide any other kind of service or information within the booth. The Exhibition Hall will be locked outside of meeting hours. IASIU and/or the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibitor property

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance

Each exhibitor is responsible for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) within its booth and assigned space. Exhibitors are required to conform to all local labor regulations.

Arrangement of Display

Exhibitor displays must be contained completely within the specified boundaries of the booth space and must comply with the following provisions. No portion of the display may extend into the aisle, adjoining booth or other areas outside the perimeter of the booth. The aisles belong to IASIU, unless otherwise noted. Exhibitor displays must provide sufficient area within the booth to accommodate the booth attendants as well as any stationary audiences which the display attracts. Exhibitors may not hang signage or banners above their booth.

Each Exhibitor is entitled to a reasonable sight line from the aisle regardless of the size of the exhibit. No exhibit shall be allowed to obstruct clear vision to other booths in the same line or adjacent lines unless it is an island display, having four corners on four sides. Display height may not exceed 4' in front two-thirds of booth or 8' in rear one-third of the booth. Character of Exhibits is subject to the approval of the IASIU seminar committee. IASIU reserves the right to refuse exhibits or parts of exhibits that are not consistent with the character of the meeting. In the case of island booths, if a solid wall is to be part of the display, or any free-standing unit above 8' feet high, or any multi-level construction above 8' feet high, a

booth rendering must be submitted to IASIU for approval of such construction in advance. All custom construction and booth designs must be approved by IASIU in advance, received and approved in writing by IASIU by July 13, 2026. Unless otherwise noted, IASIU follows trade show industry standards for booth design and installation, as developed by the International Association of Exhibitions & Events (IAEE).

Booth Preference

A final Exhibit Hall floor plan will be sent to confirmed exhibitors after approved by the local fire marshal. Booth selection is based on when payment is received. IASIU reserves the right to assign booth space.

Booth Relocation

IASIU reserves the right to adjust the floor plan at any time and relocate exhibitors should it become necessary or advisable in the best judgment of IASIU. Every effort will be made to relocate the exhibitor to another comparable space if IASIU deems such a relocation to be necessary or appropriate.

Cancellation

It is mutually agreed that in the event the IASIU Annual Conference and Expo on Insurance Fraud is canceled as a result of disasters, strikes, governmental regulations, epidemics or causes that would prevent its scheduled opening or continuance, then and thereupon, this agreement will be terminated and the management of IASIU shall determine an equitable basis for the refund of such portion of the exhibit fees as is possible after due consideration of expenditures and commitments already made.

All cancellations requested by Exhibitor must be in writing. IASIU reserves the right to consider an Exhibitor's downsizing of booth space as a cancellation of original space and purchase of new booth space. Accordingly, the Exhibitor may be required to move to a new location after requesting downsized space.

Exhibitors not occupying booth space by 4:00 pm on Sunday, August 25, 2026, will forfeit booth space without refund. The space may be resold or used at the sole discretion of IASIU.

Compliance

The exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all pertinent ordinances, regulations and codes of duly authorized local, state and federal governing bodies concerning labor, fire, safety and health, together with the rules and regulations of the operators and/or owners of the property wherein the exhibit is held. Cloth decorations must be flameproof. Wiring must comply with fire department and underwriters' rules.

SPONSORSHIP & EXHIBIT POLICIES



Conduct

IASIU monitors all exhibits. Exhibitors must staff their exhibit booth during the scheduled peak Exhibition Hall hours. Exhibitors who leave the booth unsupervised for long periods of time or vacate their booth prior to official closing time may lose consideration from exhibiting at future Annual Conferences. By registering as an exhibitor, your organization's staff agrees to follow IASIU's Code of Conduct and Anti-Trust Statement available online at: <https://www.iasiu.org/page/about>.

Conference Attire

Attire of all exhibit personnel should be consistent with the business casual atmosphere of the IASIU 2026 Annual Conference & Expo on Insurance Fraud.

Demonstrations and Canvassing

Demonstrations/live interviews, market research, etc., may not interfere with normal traffic flow nor infringe on neighboring exhibits. Demonstrations will not be permitted outside of the exhibitor's assigned booth space. Any demonstrations must be pre-approved by IASIU. Canvassing or distribution of advertising material by an exhibitor will not be permitted outside of the exhibitor's booth space. Canvassing or marketing of any product in any part of the Exhibit Hall, meeting rooms or public areas by anyone representing a non-exhibiting firm is strictly prohibited.

Eviction

IASIU reserves the right to evict any exhibitor from the trade show with or without cause. In case of eviction, 1. Exhibitor must leave the exhibit hall immediately without protest or appeal, 2. Exhibitor shall not dismantle their exhibit booth until the Trade Show ends for the day, 3. IASIU is not liable for any refunds on exhibit space or other expenses, and 4. Exhibitor will be accompanied from the exhibit hall by security, and after the Trade Show ends for the day, exhibitor shall not re-enter the exhibit hall to dismantle and remove their exhibit unless accompanied by security.

Exhibitor Appointed Contractors

Exhibitors may employ the service of independent contractors to install and dismantle their displays, providing the exhibitor and the exhibitor-appointed contractors comply with the requirements as specified in the Exhibitor Service Kit. The exhibitor must notify IASIU of the intent to utilize an independent contractor no later than July 1, 2026, furnishing the name, address and telephone number of the firm. In addition, the exhibitor shall provide evidence to IASIU that the exhibitor-appointed contractor has filed a proper certificate of insurance with a minimum of \$1million liability coverage, including property damage.

Exhibit Booth Personnel

All exhibitor personnel must register as a conference attendee prior to July 1, 2026. Each booth space includes two conference registrations, which enable admission to the welcome reception, general session, workshops and meal functions. Additional registrations will be available for the rate set for IASIU members. After booth payment is made, IASIU will send instructions for attendees to register online. Registration tickets are nonrefundable and may not be shared.

Exhibit Space

The space contracted is to be used solely by the exhibiting company whose name appears on this agreement and it is agreed that the exhibitor will not sublet or assign any portion of the same. Sharing of exhibit space is not permitted unless it is within the divisions of the same company. Any space sharing must be pre-approved by IASIU. Space is assigned after a completed Exhibitor agreement with deposit payment is received by IASIU, and is subject to availability of space preferences, special needs and compatibility of exhibitors. If during the event, the exhibitor is in violation of these rules & regulations, IASIU has, at any time, the right to regain the immediate possession of any space. Further, IASIU reserves the right to interpret these rules & regulations and determine eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in this exhibition.

Exhibit/Sponsor Fee Payment

A minimum of 50% deposit must accompany the exhibit/sponsor form. Your completed form indicates intent to exhibit/sponsor and is considered a contract once the initial payment is received. The balance due for the exhibit/sponsorship space must be paid in full by June 1, 2026. All forms received after this date must be accompanied by full payment. If not paid in full, IASIU may reassign or cancel the exhibit space without refund of deposit. There will be no inclusion of sponsor/exhibitor logo or listing on any event marketing or communications, and exhibit displays cannot be set up until all fees are paid in full.

Exhibitor Service Kit

All exhibitors will receive the Exhibitor Service Kit, after space assignments have been made. The kit will contain the following important information, including dates and deadlines for:

- Freight shipping and handling information
- Electrical and telephone service order forms
- Furniture, equipment and labor rentals

Food & Beverage

IASIU must be notified of an exhibitor's intent to distribute food or beverage items in the Exhibit Hall. All such items must be approved by IASIU and ordered through the venue. Exhibitors are not permitted to bring in outside food or beverage.

Giveaways & Contests

Exhibitors may collect entries for drawings or giveaways throughout the course of the seminar. On Wednesday, August 27, 2026 drawings will be held in the Exhibit Hall. IASIU reserves the right to update the format, cancel or change the vendor raffle.

Guest Passes

The Exhibit Hall at IASIU 2026 is a professional show for the use and information of the meeting's registered delegates and registered guests. As such, no passes for guests of exhibit personnel are issued.

Indemnification and Insurance

The exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend, and save IASIU, the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort and their employees and agents harmless against all claims, losses, and damages to persons or property, government charges or fines, and attorney's fees arising out of or caused by exhibitor's installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy, or use of the Expo premises or part thereof, excluding any such liability caused by the negligence of said parties, employees or agents. In addition, the exhibitor acknowledges that neither IASIU nor the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort maintains insurance covering the exhibitor's property and that it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by the exhibitor. Exhibitors wishing to insure their exhibit materials and goods against theft or damage by fire, accident or loss of any kind must do so at their own expense. Every exhibitor is responsible for obtaining insurance (liability, fire and theft) in such amounts deemed appropriate to comply with its obligations hereunder.

IASIU Logo Usage

The name, logo and acronym of the International Association of Special Investigation Units and IASIU 2026 are proprietary marks. Any use of these marks is strictly prohibited, for any purpose, without written permission and approval of IASIU. Permission to use the name, logo and acronym (IASIU) of the International Association of Special Investigation Units must be requested at least two weeks prior to the printing or intended usage of the mark(s). Written requests for logo usage should include a clear description of how the name, logo or acronym will be used as well as a sample of the intended piece. If approval is granted, an electronic file of the IASIU logo will be made available.

Client Logo Usage

Client logo (in EPS, vector format) and URL (for posting on the conference website and other platforms) must be submitted to IASIU upon signing agreement. Client agrees that IASIU may use logo for any and all event marketing and communication vehicles.

Installation & Dismantle

Exhibits may be installed beginning Sunday, August 24, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. and must be completed by 5:30 p.m. Exhibit dismantling will begin after the last break on Tuesday, August, 26, 2026. No dismantling will be permitted before closing time, and no exhibitor shall have the right to pack or remove articles on display prior to show closing without prior approval from IASIU.

Photo Release

We occasionally use photographs or videos of our exhibitors in promotional materials. By virtue of your attendance, you automatically agree to usage of your likeness in such materials.

Photography & Taping

No photography and/or videotaping will be permitted without prior written authorization by IASIU.

Rules & Regulations Changes

IASIU reserves the right to change or modify these rules and regulations as deemed appropriate to improve the Trade Show. All policies and procedures stated herein and as detailed within this document will be in effect until further notice.

Security & Uncontrollables

Reasonable precaution against damages or loss by fire, water, theft and other emergencies will be taken, including after-hours security, but IASIU does not guarantee, nor insure the exhibitor against loss by reason thereof. In case the premises to be used by the exhibit shall be destroyed by fire or elements, or by any other cause, or in case any other circumstances shall make it impossible for IASIU to permit the said premises to be occupied by said exhibitor for use, herein specified, then and thereupon this agreement shall terminate, and the said exhibitor shall and hereby does waive any claim for damages or compensation. It is agreed that IASIU reserves the right to retain such part of the payments made by exhibitors for booth space as would be necessary to cover all expenses incurred by IASIU incidental to the opening of the Trade Show, up to the time of cancellation.

Selling on the Exhibit Floor

Exhibitors are not permitted to execute financial transactions on the exhibit floor without written approval from IASIU. If IASIU permits such transactions, the exhibitor is solely responsible for abiding by the local and state sales tax codes. Non-exhibitors may not market products on the exhibit floor. Any person violating the Rules set forth in this section will be immediately evicted from the Exhibit Hall.

Sound Devices

The use of sound devices for mechanical reproduction of sound is restricted. In general, the employment of any method of projection of sound beyond the exhibitor's booth is prohibited and show management reserves the right to discontinue amplification, and to close any booth for failure to comply with requests to limit noise projected beyond the booth.

Shipping

Shipping will be coordinated through the show decorator. Exhibitors must adhere to procedures detailed in the Exhibitor Service Kit. Exhibitors are responsible for coordination and payment of all their freight to and from the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort. If an exhibitor's freight is still at show site at the end of the published hours for show dismantle, the show's decorator will place that freight with a freight carrier at the expense of the exhibiting company. Collateral must arrive at the show decorator's warehouse by the designated days as outlined in the Exhibitor Service Kit. Return packing and shipment of any collateral is the responsibility of the Exhibitor only.
