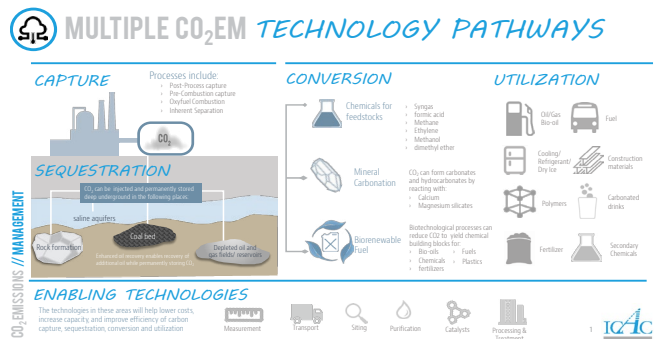


EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION
