A letter of recommendation from the employer will also be required for interns that are applying. Please be sure to attach the letter to your application when you apply if you applying as an intern.
- Prefer an insurance or finance major but other majors will be considered
- Must be attending a 4 year college
- Must be attending a public, state or private college or university for 2019-2020 school year (junior colleges not acceptable).
- Must be a graduating high school senior or a current college student for the 2018-2019 school year that resides in Travis County or a contiguous county.

- The application must be received March 1, 2019. No applications can be accepted after that date.
- Scholarships recipients will be notified by March 31, 2019.
