Eric is a Vice President in the Regional Community and Foreign Banking Function of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York's Financial Institution Supervision Group. Mr. Caban currently runs the Foreign Banking Organization Department which covers over 135 foreign banks spanning over 60 countries.

Eric is also a member of the ("FBO") Subcommittee of the Large and Foreign Banking Organizations Management Group ("LFBOMG"). The mission of the FBO Subcommittee is to foster the effective implementation and consistent application of the supervision program for FBOs with consolidated U.S. assets less than \$100 billion.

Prior to his role in the International Banking area Mr. Caban was responsible for assessing Basel II implementation at complex financial institutions and led the Basel II Advanced Measurement Approach qualification team responsible for coordinating Basel II supervision across the U.S. Mr. Caban also led the Federal Reserve's efforts in stress testing Operational Risk for the Comprehensive Capital Analysis and Review (CCAR) exercise.

Eric received his B.S. in Finance and International Business from New York University and his M.B.A. in Finance and Entrepreneurship from Columbia University.
