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Sexual Harassment Prevention Training (1 Hour required every renewal period)

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Mandated Reporter Training (1 Hour required every 3 years)

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Ethics Training (3 CEs required every renewal period)

LCPC ONLY – Clinical Supervision (9 CEs required– Lifetime requirement)

When do I need to get my CEs?

Counselors are required to get 30 CEs every renewal cycle. This renewal cycle your CEs are to be earned on or after April 1, 2025 and before March 31, 2027. Some of these CEs include mandated trainings and the rest are non-mandated. You can find the full requirements [here](#) or online at www.ilcounseling.org > Licensure > Renewal Requirements.

Note: if this is your first renewal for LPC/LCPC licensure you are not required to get any CEs, but you must complete the following mandated trainings: Alzheimer's Awareness, Cultural Competency, Implicit Bias, Mandated Reporter, and Sexual Harassment Prevention trainings.

What if I took a training before this renewal cycle?

Trainings can only be applied to the licensure cycle in which they were taken. Any CEs acquired on or before March 31, 2025 will not be eligible for use for your licensure renewal in March of 2027.

Who can provide me with CEs?

An approved CE provider must be licensed with IDFPR. ICA is an approved CE provider for LPC/LCPCs, LSW/LCSWs, LMFTs, and psychologists. You can find the full list of IDFPR approved providers [here](#).

Do I need to fulfill the supervision requirement?

If you are an LCPC, you are required to complete the 9 CEs in Clinical Supervision training before your second licensure renewal and in order to be a qualified supervisor. This is a one-time, life time requirement, so once you fulfill this requirement you do not need to complete it again. You do not need to complete this training if you are an LPC.

How do I apply for licensure renewal?

Once the license renewal period is active, IDFPR should notify all license holders via e-mail approximately 60 days out from the March 31, 2027 deadline. Please note that whether or not you receive notice from IDFPR, you are still responsible to renew your license by the deadline.
