

Eva Nieminski Honorary Graduate Science Engineering Scholarship

Purpose:

The Eva Nieminski Honorary Graduate Science and Engineering Scholarship was created by the Intermountain Section of the AWWA to encourage science education and training related to the field of conservation, water quality, supply, resources, reuse or treatment and to support an outstanding undergraduate student in that field

Eligibility:

Students are eligible to apply who are enrolled in a graduate science or engineering program in the Intermountain West and whose research interests involve water quality, supply, or treatment. Students who have been accepted into such a graduate program but have not yet begun coursework are also eligible to apply. Applicants for this scholarship are considered without consideration of race, gender, color, or creed. Students are eligible to receive

Timeline:

The application and all required supporting materials must be received by the Intermountain Section of the AWWA no later than **December 5th 2019**. The recipient will be notified and the award sum will be notified by a webinar after the New Year.

Support Provided:

This scholarship will be awarded as a one-time grant in the amount of \$1,000 and a year's IMS AWWA membership with educational and career opportunities.

Application Requirements:

Send all materials required in the application for scholarship in one document in a pdf. format. Along with the attached application form, please send:

- A complete resume
- An essay regarding your academic interests and career goals and how they are relevant to water quality, supply, or treatment in the Intermountain West.
- Two letters of recommendation (submittal instructions on next page)

Selection Criteria:

Members of the Student Outreach and Scholarship Committee of the Intermountain Section of the American Water Works Association will review all submitted application materials

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Applicants will be evaluated based on:

- The applicant's letters of recommendation
- The quality of the applicant's essay
- The applicant's potential to contribute to the field of water quality, supply and treatment in the Intermountain West.



Application and Letter of Recommendation Submittal Instructions

Please include the following in your application as one pdf. Document

- Scholarship Application Form (page 3 of this document)
- Resume
- Essay on your academic interests and career goals relevant to water quality, supply or treatment in the Intermountain West
- 2 Letters of Recommendation

We ask that you include the scholarship in the subject line in the email you use to submit you package. We also would like your application, resume and essay as one pdf. document saved as the scholarship your applying for then your name.

Please make sure your package is complete before you submit it by email to nicoleb@ims-awwa.org. Your application must be received by **December 5th 2019**. All applications received after the submittal time will not be considered.

Each applicant is asked to submit two letters of recommendation as part of the application process of the IMS AWWA Section scholarships. These letters can be written by an instructor or professor working closely with the applicant in an individual research program or course of study. The letters can be submitted by the student or by the person writing the letter on the student's behalf. Letters submitted by instructors and professors must be received by **December 5th 2019** in order to be considered for the scholarship. The student the recommendation is written for should be included in the subject line.
