

## **Hon. Robert R. Altice, Jr.**

**Robert R. Altice, Jr.**, was appointed to the Court by Governor Pence and began serving on Sept. 2, 2015. He earned his B.A. from Miami University, OH; an M.S. in criminal justice administration from the University of Central Missouri; and his law degree from the University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Law. Judge Altice was a deputy prosecutor in Jackson County, MO, then focused on medical malpractice defense with a Kansas City firm. He later joined an Indianapolis firm, concentrating on insurance defense. From 1994-2000, Judge Altice prosecuted major felonies for the Marion County Prosecutor's Office, including three years as Chief of the Felony Division. After his 2000 election to the Marion County bench, he presided at more than 250 major felony jury trials and 15 civil jury trials. He was Presiding Judge of the Marion Superior Court from 2009-2011. Judge Altice is a member of the Indiana Judges Association, has served on the Board of Directors of the Judicial Conference of Indiana, and was a member of the Indiana Judicial Conference Community Relations Committee and Civil Bench Book Committee.
